Sick Policy

FEVER of	Must be fever free (any temperature above 100.0 degrees) for at least 24 hours <u>without the use of fever reducing medications.</u>
RASH	Return time based on written doctor’s evaluation and clearance in writing that it is not contagious
CONJUNCTIVITIS	Must have written diagnosis from doctor explaining exactly what irritation and discharge from the eyes is from: Bacterial Conjunctivitis – must have 24 hrs of treatment Viral Conjunctivitis – may return as long as there is not discharge Pink Eye – after 24 hours of treatment, must have a confirmation from doctor in writing that child is no longer contagious.
DIARRHEA	Must stay home the next day for observation. Must be diarrhea free for 24 hours with at least 1 regular bowel movement
VOMITING	Must stay home the next day for observation. Child must be symptom free with no vomiting for at least 24 hours
PERSISTANT HACKING COUGH	Must stay home the next day for observation. Must return with a diagnosis from doctor in writing and at least 24 hours of treatment. If in fact no treatment is required, we need a doctor’s note with a diagnosis of exactly what it is with a clearance that it is not contagious.
LICE	Must be treated for 24 hours and nit free. The Director and Lead Teacher will make an evaluation and determine if the child can be readmitted
THICK WHITE, GREEN OR YELLOW DISCHARGE	Must stay home the next day for observation. Must return with a diagnosis from doctor in writing and at least 24 hours of treatment. If in fact there is no infection, we need a doctor’s note confirming what it is and that the child is not contagious
